Welcome to the Eukanuba Performance Games presented by K9 Sport Fest! CBFT & K9U are happy to host all of you at this one of a kind event! Make sure to enjoy all of what K9 Sport Fest has to offer; 10 different sports, tons of vendors, photo booths, contests, food trucks and the K9SF café & bar!

**Arrival:** 35 Fair St, Maxville, Ontario, K0C 1T0 is the address for the Maxville Fairgrounds. That address will bring you to spectator entry, you want to enter by competitor entry. It is indicated on the map below with a star. Turn onto Marlborough Street and follow it to Access Lane. We are not having parking passes this year, your name will be on a guest list. Once you've checked into competitor entry, you will receive a wristband. Please wear your wristband for the entire weekend. The grounds open at 6 AM and you're able to drive your vehicle up to the arena until 8:30 am. Then you must move your vehicle to competitors parking (blue box). The green boxes are the suggested crating areas, crating out of your car is not allowed. There's an additional map further below with information regarding the other sports and vendors. You can drive your vehicle back up to the arena to pack up after 5 pm. Indoor crating is available (purple star) inside the barn.



**Judge:** Eloise Chateauneuf is our head judge for both days!

**Racing Format:**

Regular 1 (Saturday & Sunday), Regular 2 (Saturday), Multi (Saturday), Open 2 (Sunday): Single round robin and single elimination, 3 of 5 format. One point will be awarded for every race won, zero points for losses and tied races. Divisional placement will be awarded to 3<sup>rd</sup> place based on the results of the single elimination.

Open 1 (Saturday): Double round robin, 5 of 5 format. One point will be awarded for every heat won, zero points for losses and tied races. Divisional placement will be awarded to 3<sup>rd</sup> place based on the results of the round robin.

Open 1 (Sunday): Single round robin, 3 of 5 format. One point will be awarded for every race won, zero points for losses and tied races. Divisional placement will be awarded to 3<sup>rd</sup> place based on the results of the round robin.

Tie Breaker: All two-way ties will be resolved by head-to-head racing results. If still tied, it will be decided by best time head-to-head, and then best time overall. All three or more way ties will be resolved by best time overall.

**Conflicts:** All conflicts have been divided by the "Greenies" class. We know it's a small tournament and some clubs have multiple teams entered. If you need a few extra minutes at a certain point, we understand. Please inform the head table and the opposing team if racing will be delayed.

**Greenies:** This class is only for dogs not listed on any timesheet that day. They will be given 7 minutes to use the lanes as they see fit. Greenies was by preregistration only and have been scheduled into the regular racing day.

**Start Time & Measuring:** Racing will begin at 9 am on both days. A captains' meeting will be held at 8:45 am and measuring at 8:30 am on both days. Please be prepared and bring your CRN with you. Timesheets can be picked up each morning from the head table.

**Lunch:** The duration of the lunch break will be based on the racing pace. There are several food vendors on site and even an ice cream truck!

**Warm-ups:** We will have 2 minute warm ups for each team's first race of the day and then we will reduce to 1 minute warm ups.

**Raffle Table:** Since it is a public event, the raffle table will be behind the hockey boards. Raffle tickets can be purchased from the head table. The raffle will be drawn Sunday afternoon. If you purchase tickets on Saturday and won't be there for the draw on Sunday, please write your name on your tickets and we will arrange delivery/pick up if you win.

**Workers' Raffle:** To keep racing moving as well as possible, we will need help for box judging and line judging, particularly when we run our own dogs. As a thank you for

your help, you will receive a raffle ticket to be placed in the bucket at the head table for a special prize!

**Poop Depot:** You will be rewarded for picking up after your dog! Bring your dog's deposit to the "Poop Depot" and you will be entered into a draw for one of several gift baskets.

**Camping:** Camping is only available by pre-registration. Campers should have received all of their camping information directly from K9 Sport Fest. If you have questions regarding camping, please contact K9SF.
